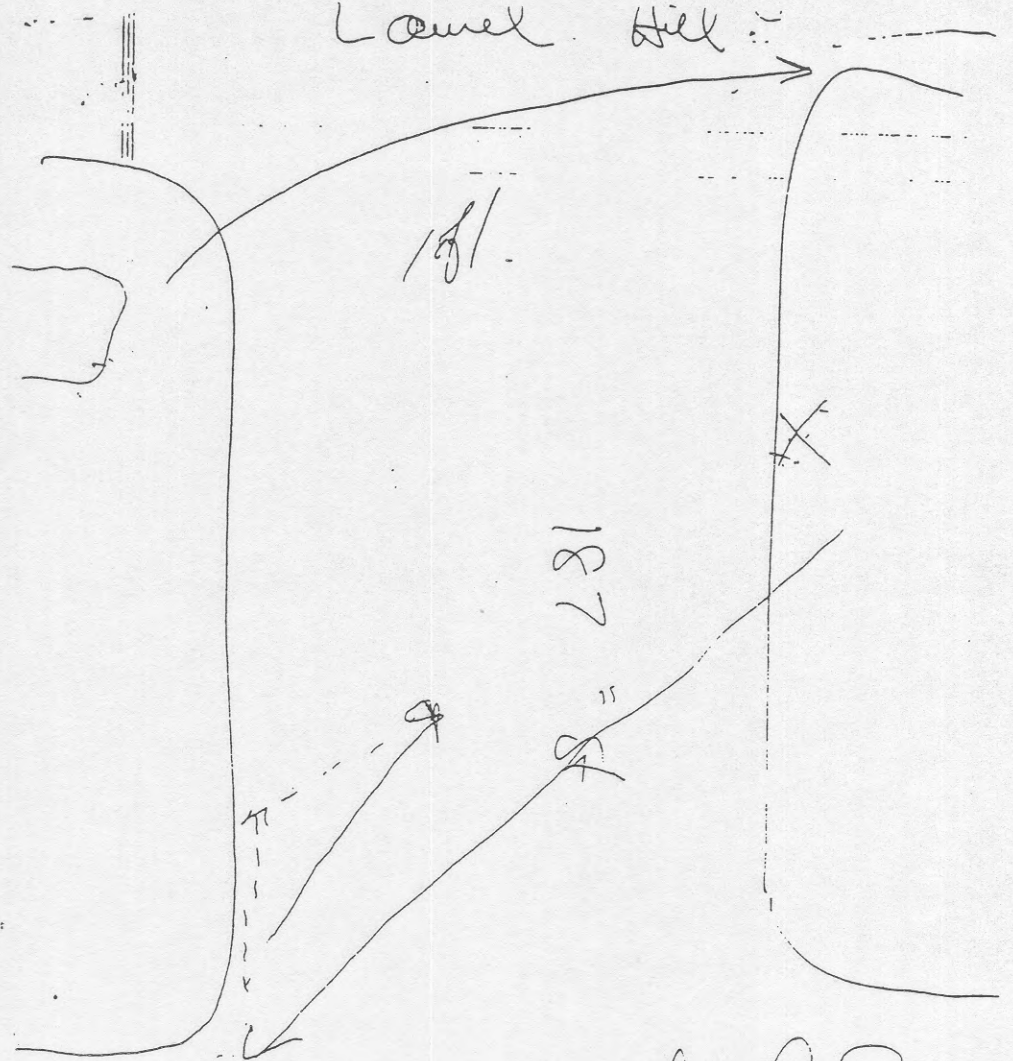

On the date at sometime after seven in  
the evening I was hanging out with several  
of my friends from the neighborhood on 187<sup>th</sup> street  
between Laurel Hill Terrace and Amsterdam Ave.  
We were sitting on parked cars diagonally  
opposite 485<sup>th</sup> W 187<sup>th</sup> St. At this time I  
got off the car and walked diagonally  
across the street to the N/E corner of  
187<sup>th</sup> St and Amsterdam Ave to look for the  
ice cream truck. As I was walking across  
the street I heard 3 loud bangs like  
an aluminum pot hitting metal, evenly spaced  
apart. I looked up to the park for the  
truck and then turned and started to walk  
back across the street. Halfway across I  
saw two male Hispanics come running out  
of 485 W 187<sup>th</sup> St at full speed and run  
towards Laurel Hill Terrace South bound.  
I lost sight of them as they passed the  
corner. I asked my friends if they heard  
the shots and saw said "yes" believing they  
came from the park. I said to them "I saw

Checked that several persons were in the street but no one told me they saw anything. About five or six minutes later the police arrived. A while after the incident I approached a uniform officer and obtained a card to call the police and car in.
