2. Examination and comparison of the above described evidence caused the following opinions to be formed:

- a. The questioned "Faul Dudley White MD" stamps which were affixed to the evidence Q3 and Q4 can be jigsaw matched to the known "Faul Dudley White MD" stamps K14.
- b. The questioned typewriting appearing on the evidence Q1, Q2 and Q5 is consistent with each other but different from the known typewriting appearing on K16A-D, K17A-C, K18A-D, K19 and K20.
- c. Some strong similarities exist between the questioned writing appearing on the evidence Q3 thru Q6 and the known writing appearing on the evidence K1 - K13, K15A-B, K16D and K21.
- 3. If further attention is required in this matter, it is suggested that additional known writing in the amount, style and wording as directed by the undersigned be obtained by court order from the suspect in this case.
- 4. If testimony is required, it is suggested that this examiner be notified at least ten (10) working days prior to such testimony. This is necessary to prepare the proper exhibits for court presentation.
- 5. The evidence described above will be retained in the files of the Police Laboratory's Document Unit for future reference.
